Forest Legacy is a national program funded by the US Forest Service to protect environmentally important areas that are threatened by conversion to non-forest uses. The program keeps working forests working by purchasing conservation easements that remove the development rights of a tract of privately-held forest land.





Grants available to **communities**, **nonprofits** and **tribes** for acquisition of lands at least **5 acres** in size, **75% forested** & which provide **community benefits** and **public access**.



The Community Forest Program is funded by the US Forest Service to protect environmentally important areas that are threatened by development. Program priorites are to provide community benefits through sustainable forest managment, environmental benefits, experiential learning, effective forest stewardship and recreational opportunities.
